

Before installing the pendant light, map out the installation points on the ceiling according to the measurements shown below. The Z-BAR pendant light will be hung vertically from these 4 points.

Please note that Square-24 and Square-16 fixtures have different dimensions.






Using the provided DC cable & connectors, connect the wires inside the transformer enclosure as illustrated in the Wiring Diagram below. A transformer needs to be installed for every location marked with the symbol (





4) Return the defective product to Koncept freight prepaid and accompanied by (1), (2), and (3) to the following address:





Canopy installation



Monopoint installation Multipoint installation

There are two ways to mount the Z-Bar pendant square, a monopoint installation or a multipoint installation. For monopoint installation, proceed to step 2. For multipoint, see below.


Multipoint Installation : Before installing the pendant light, locate the installation points on the ceiling for the wire hangers, according to the distance away from the junction box/canopy listed on the diagram below. The Z-BAR pendant light should be hung vertically off the 4 points shown on the map below.






Canopy installation

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


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
Connect the AC wires from the wall to the terminals. Affix the wires to the terminal with a flathead screw driver

Feed the AC power cord from the junction box through the hole as shown in the figure on the right then connect the AC wires to the terminals. Use a flathead screw driver to tighten the screws in the terminal to affix the wires. Secure the canopy to the ceiling with 3 provided screws, make sure the canopy is centered to the junction box and fully covering the junction box.

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Canopy installation (Multipoint)




Affix the holders to the 3 locations (other than the canopy) marked on the ceiling from step #1 with screws. Then screw the cable grippers into the holders. Wires can be released and re-adjusted by pressing onto the nozzle.

Using the nut & cable gripper in the bag labeled "b", feed the DC power cord, from the joint in the container labeled 🗲 , through the provided nut, then throught the face plate, and then through the provided cable gripper as shown. Connect the DC wires to the DC terminal. Pull the core wire out and fit it into the + positive terminal. Twist the skin of the wire and fit it into the - negative terminal. Affix the wires to the terminal with a flat head screw driver. Secure the cable gripper to the face plate by tightening the nut to the cable gripper.

Tighten two screws from the sides to secure the face plate.



Attach LED light bars to the joints and make sure they are fully inserted with no gaps. Ensure each joint is positioned so that the joint's center opening is always facing inward, and not upward, downward or outward of the entire fixture.



Wires can be released and re-adjusted by pressing the cable grippers' "nozzle".

Pull the core wire out and fit it into the + positive terminal. Twist the skin of the wire and fit it into the - negative terminal.
