Founded in 2018, Sill Design is a high end interior design studio based in the Portland area. The studio specializes in design forward, highly personalized spaces created in close collaboration with homeowners. While residential design is at the heart of their work, Sill Design also brings their perspective to select small scale commercial projects.

With a strong appreciation for handmade tiles, layered textures, living finishes, and rich materiality, Sill Design creates spaces that feel personal and thoughtfully considered.

Located in Northeast Portland's Concordia neighborhood, this primary bathroom was part of a bold transformation of the clients' suite. Sill Design centered the concept around "Raw & Radiant," bringing together earthy tones, warm wood, handmade tile, layered textures, and unexpected pops of color. The result is a space that feels grounded and natural while still allowing room for playful details, from the blue bathtub to the sculptural arched vanity.



For the bathtub area, Sill Design wanted a fixture that could bring warmth and softness to the space while adding another thoughtful detail to the design.

The team discovered Koncept through their Lumens trade account and worked directly through the Lumens website during the selection process. They ultimately chose the 9 inch Ramen Wall Sconce in Oiled Walnut. Ericka explains, "We really appreciate the craftsmanship and attention to detail that goes into Koncept's light fixtures. The designs feel thoughtfully considered and beautifully made, with a strong focus on materiality and form."



The warm walnut finish complements the custom walnut casework throughout the bathroom, creating a natural connection between the lighting and cabinetry. Rather than placing the sconces in a traditional linear arrangement, Sill Design positioned them diagonally to add movement and visual interest around the bathtub.

With several layers of lighting throughout the space, the team also wanted flexibility to adjust the atmosphere. Placing the Ramen sconces on dimmers allowed them to fine tune the light and create a more relaxed setting around the bathtub.

For Sill Design, the project was an opportunity to create something unexpected and personal for their clients. Their clients brought a strong background in art and a deep appreciation for handmade tiles, layered textures, and living finishes, while also trusting the studio with the freedom to push the design.

That trust can be seen throughout the finished space. From the unexpected blue bathtub to the arched vanity and diagonal placement of the Ramen Wall Sconces, each detail contributes to a bathroom that feels distinctly personal.

The project also reflects the collaborative nature of the design process. Sill Design worked alongside talented trade partners, including general contractor Aura Construction, who helped bring the vision to life.

Available in 9 inch and 12 inch sizes, the Ramen Wall Sconce features nine interchangeable face plate options, including wood, metal, and felt, with paintable plates for further customization. Its wet rated design makes it well suited for bathroom applications, while ELV dimmer compatibility gives designers control over the lighting experience. Producing 1500 lumens at 3000K, Ramen provides a warm, diffused glow that works naturally within a range of residential and commercial spaces.

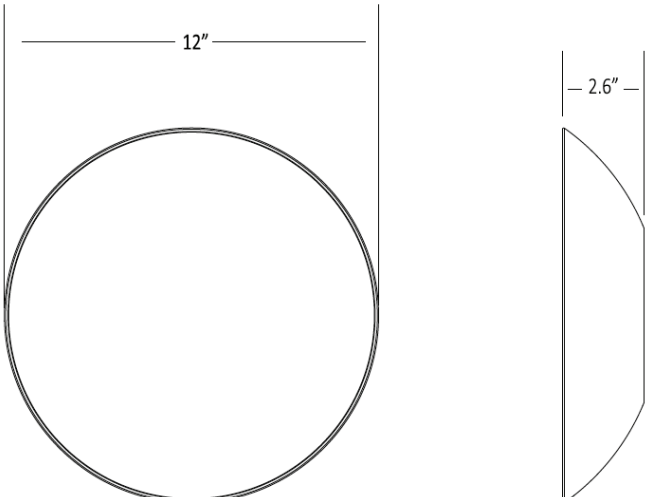
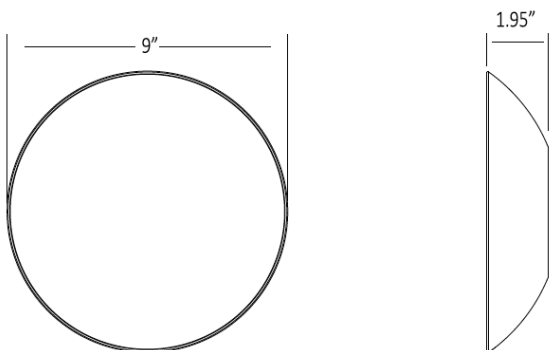
